Accepted full papers will be published in edited book published by Springer and the MTMI publication: <u>Review of</u> <u>Business and Technology Research (RBTR)</u>. It is assumed that the paper submitted is author's original work and have

similarity index (8 words count) below 20%. The published papers in the RBTR will have copyright of MTMI. The final paper in template must be submitted by the deadline to be included in the book published by Springer and the RBTR.
