THE SUBMISSION DEADLINE OF FINAL PAPER DUE DATE IS AUGUST 15, 2020.

Accepted full papers will be published in the MTMI publication: Review of Business and Technology Research (RBTR). It is assumed that the paper submitted is author's original work and have a similarity index (8 words count) below 20%. The accepted published papers in the RBTR shall be the copyright of MTMI. The paper must be submitted by the deadline to be included in the RBTR.
